Benicàssim is designed to enhance the quality of life of visitors and residents. A good example of this are the parks and gardens located all throughout the city. They are integrated into the residential areas, meaning it is easy to come across one of these spaces devoted to relaxation or children's recreation while taking a pleasant stroll.

The thirty-three medium-sized parks and gardens boast children's play equipment and outdoor furniture, as

well as adapted games, trees and water points, to make your stay as enjoyable as possible. They are constantly cared for and maintained through a number of efforts and projects intended to improve their botanical and ornamental conditions over time.

Benicàssim has also opened several dog off-leash areas in strategic points across the city. All parks are freely accessible throughout the year.

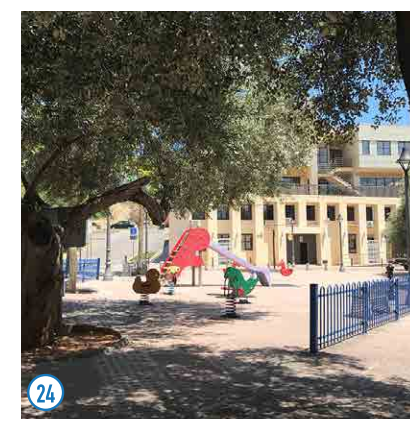

The beginning of the Castellón-Tarragona train line was commissioned to Compañía de Ferrocarriles del Norte whose engineer was Joaquín Coloma. Since then, the evolution of the railways has always been linked to the city and this park is a tribute to that tradition.

The Parque del Trenet, or 'miniature train park', is the largest of the municipality's parks, spanning over 11,600 square meters of gardens with an extra special attraction: a miniature train journey on which children and adults alike can relive the experience of riding on a steam train. However, as in real life, diesel and electric locomotives also have their place here.



The Farja Railway Association is responsible for maintaining and running the track and providing information to visitors.

The miniature train can be visited every Sunday morning and, in July and August, it has longer opening hours several days a week. For further information: www.aafcas.es

Not only that, the park also has a very unique signposted botanical trail, which allows visitors to discover some thirty rare botanical species, making this green space the ideal place to enjoy with the family.



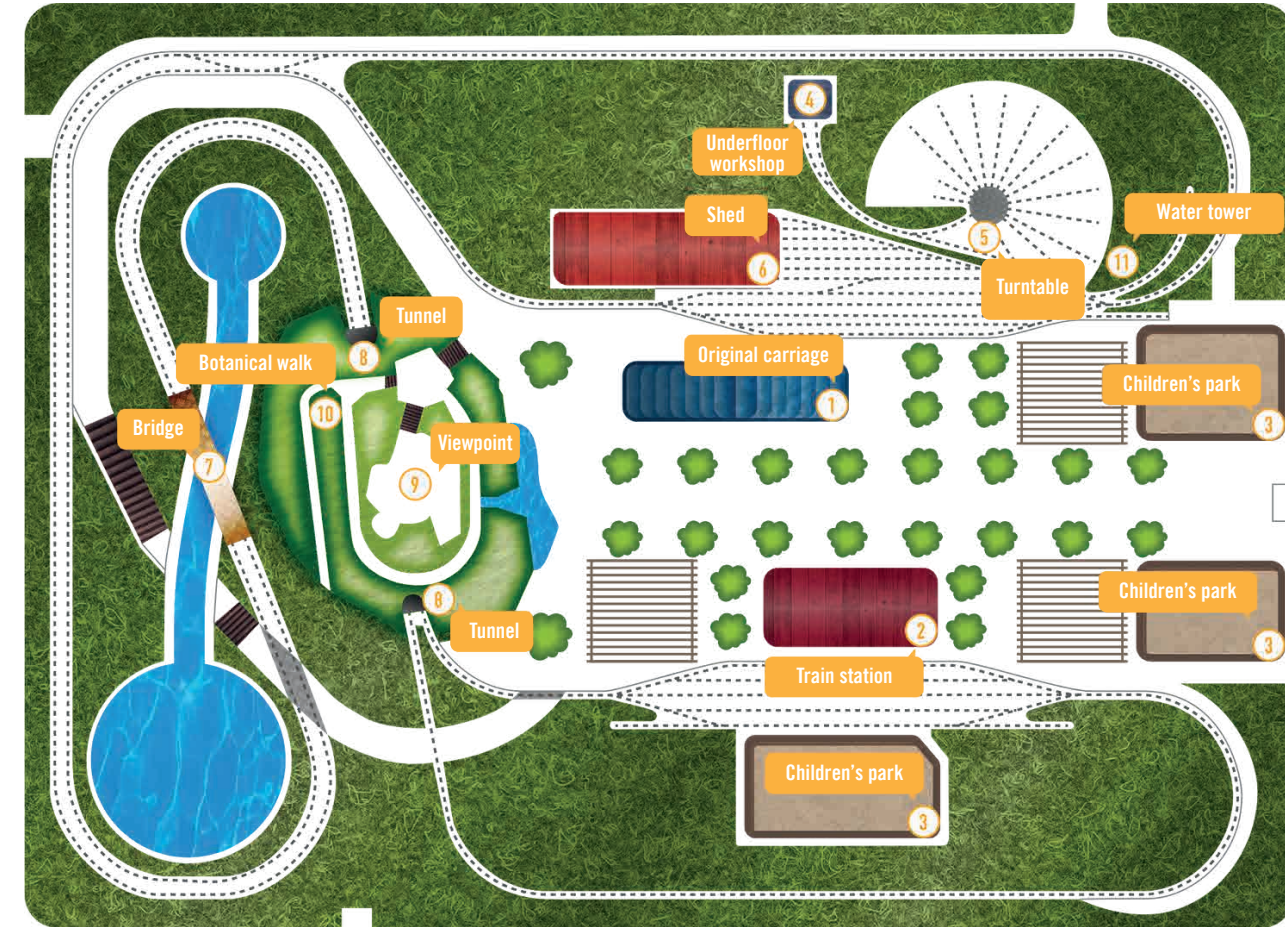

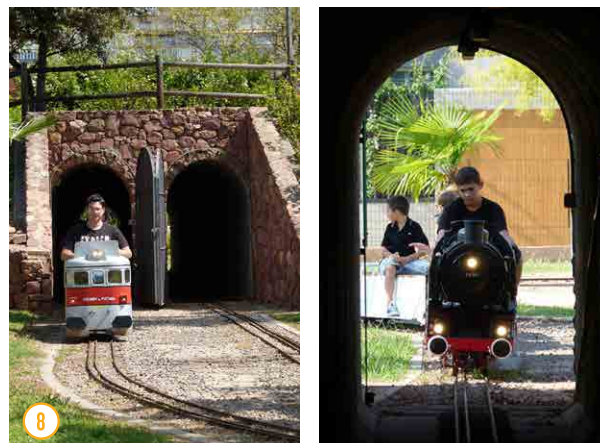
