HELP KEEP OUR BEACHES CLEAN

The following **REGULATIONS** apply to the use of Benicàssim's beaches:

- Use of any sound reproduction devices is strictly forbidden.
- No pets allowed from 1 March to 31 October.
- Games or sports that might disturb or pose physical danger to other beach-goers must be practised in the dedicated areas only.
- Unregulated sale or advertising of goods and services is not allowed.
- Use of jet skis without a licence, registration or insurance is strictly forbidden.
- No sailing closer than 50 metres to the coastline or other sea vessels, or 200 metres from the beach.
- No bathing when the red flag is raised.
- Bathers and recreational float users must heed the advice of the lifeguards and indicator flags.
- No camping on the beach.
- No gels or other cleaning products may be used in the full-body or foot showers.
- Any other provision set out in the “Safety, enjoyment and use of Benicàssim's coast by-laws”.

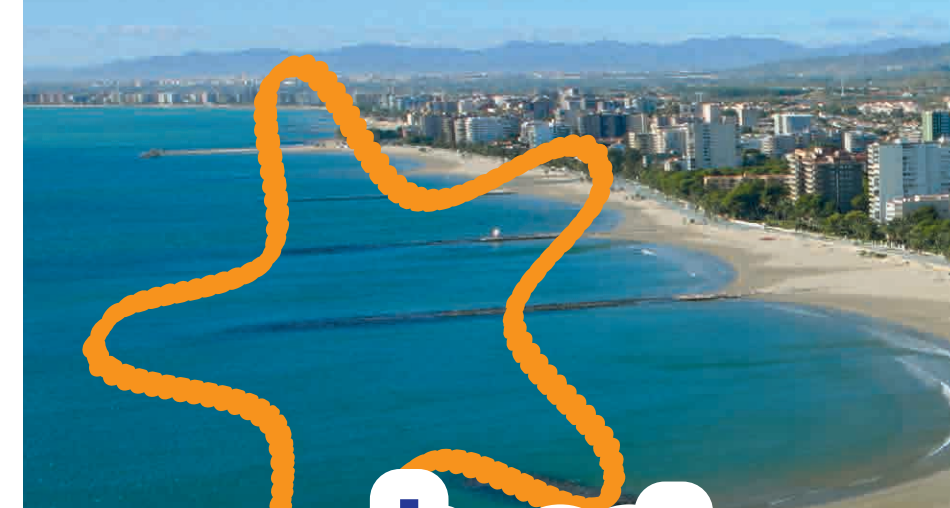

Benicàssim's coastline stretches for nearly 7km and is split into five beaches: **Voramar, Almadraba, Torre San Vicente, Els Terrers** and **Heliópolis**, all of which have been awarded the **Blue Flag distinction** and **ISO 14001** in environmental management. Voramar, Almadraba and Torre San Vicente have all additionally received the Spanish **Tourism Quality** Institute's “Q” certificate for quality, safety and professionalism.

Benicàssim's beaches are much more than just beaches. They are history, when you spend the day visiting the stunning villas and travel back in time to the Belle Époque. Or to medieval times when, resting in the shade of the old look-out post, St. Vincent's Tower, you imagine what it would have been like to live here when pirates still raided this stretch of coast. They are sport, with all five boasting sports facilities of some kind, whether beach-based or sea-based, like heading out to sea on a sail boat or jet ski from the Sailing School. They are also a place for rest and relaxation, a place where you can take a gentle stroll along the promenade, stopping at one of the seafront terraces to try a local delicacy. And they are culture, when you visit the beach libraries and delve into your favourite book while listening to the soothing sounds of the sea.

HELIÓPOLIS BEACH

LENGTH 2.650 m. - WIDTH 50 m.



This beach has a long seafront promenade from where the visitor can enjoy the sights and sounds of the sea, or loan a book from the beach library. The 16km scenic cyclo-tourism route that goes as far as Castellon, joining the Via Verde del Mar “Green Line” as far as Oropesa, begins here.



During the summer months many activities are organised here, such as the local arts and crafts fair, beach gym, children’s entertainment, and open-air cinema.

Umbrella, sun bed and skate hire, volleyball and rugby, children’s play area. Quay, Fishing School and surfboard hire. Awarded the European Blue Flag certificate and ISO 14001 in environmental management.

ELS TERRERS BEACH

LENGTH 1.730 m. - WIDTH 35 m.



Els Terrers beach is a wide beach with raised wooden walkways along the length of its seafront. Sailing courses of all levels are available at the Generalitat Valenciana’s Sailing School, whose tall masts lend this beach its unique aspect. The beach is split into two main zones: a sandy area, which is where we find the Sailing School, and a pebble beach area with a viewpoint offering panoramic views.



Over the summer season there are many activities to choose from, including the open-air cinema. It has been awarded the European Blue Flag certificate and ISO 14001 in environmental management.

TORRE SANT VICENT BEACH

LENGTH 650 m. - WIDTH 85 m.



This beach takes its name from the magnificent sixteenth-century look-out post that dominates the horizon. It is one of the most popular beaches all year round. Many events are held here, day and night throughout the summer season, such as the Habanera Festival, the Ballroom Dance Festival and the traditional beach bonfires of St. John’s Night. Plus, children’s entertainment, beach gym and various sports competitions.

A gently-sloping, sandy beach with numerous services,, including instructors to inform and



supervise all those who want to engage in more active beach activities.

It has a pedestrian-only seafront promenade, volleyball courts, children’s games, as well as umbrella, sun bed and skate hire points.

Awarded the European Blue Flag certificate for clean and safe beaches, ISO 14001 in environmental management and the Spanish Tourism Quality Institute’s “Q” certificate for quality, safety and professionalism.

ALMADRABA BEACH

LENGTH 600 m. - WIDTH 60 m.



This beach gets its name from the tunny fishing nets or ‘almadrabas’ that were set up along this stretch of coast in times gone by. As with the Voramar and Torre San Vicente beaches, it has a pedestrian-only seafront promenade, giving it a peaceful feel.

Gently-sloping and sandy, it is above all an accessible beach: it has walkways running right to the sea, changing rooms, toilet facilities, amphibious chairs and qualified personnel at the service of all bathers. It also has umbrella, sun bed and skate hire points and a beach library.

Awarded the European Blue Flag certificate for clean and safe beaches, ISO 14001 in environmental management and the Spanish Tourism Quality Institute’s “Q” certificate for quality, safety and professionalism.

VORAMAR BEACH

LENGTH 500 m. - WIDTH 60 m.



Voramar beach is an extension of the peace and quiet of the residential area it backs onto. Along the length of the Torre San Vicente, Almadraba and Voramar beaches, you can see Benicàssim’s stunning early twentieth-century villas from the seafront promenade. It is in this idyllic setting that tourism really began in this seaside town. We particularly recommend Villa Elisa and its magnificent gardens, owned by the local council.

A gently-sloping, sandy beach with numerous services, it has pedestrian-only seafront promenade, and umbrella, sun bed and skate hire points.
