#### HIKING BY THE LIGHT OF THE STARS

Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> August & Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August (9.30 p.m.- midnight)

Place: La Bartola Interpretation Center parking

Difficulty: easy. (+7 years old). Price: 3€ (1.5€ reduced)

Description: Did you know that around the polar star revolve an infinity of stars organized into constellations? On this route and with the help of our guide, we will learn to orient ourselves looking at the sky, learn about the main asterisms of the summer season and dive among the myths surrounding the planets of our solar system

Distance: 4.3 km

Difficulty: easy (+ 7 years old) Price: 3€ (1.5€ reduced)

Description: The Desert de les Palmes Natural Park boasts a wide range of environments, making it the home of a variety of wildlife. This means we will discover the Park through a new lens on this hike: that of its nocturnal creatures. At every stop along the way, we will meet one of the many species lurking in our surroundings as we hike this easy trail.

Recommendations: sports footwear, cap, water, supper and a flashlight. Animals are not allowed during the activity (except for guide and assistance dogs).

### THE UNIVERSE SEEN FROM THE BARTOLO HILL

Thursday, 24<sup>th</sup> August (7.30 p.m. – 00.30 a.m.)

Place: Desert de Les Palmes Monastery car park CV-147/km.8

Distance: 7.5 km. Elevation difference: 300 m

Difficulty: easy. (+ 8 years old) Price: 5€ (2.5€ reduced).

Description: Starting at the Carmelite Convent of the Desert de les Palmes, we will walk up whilst admiring the stunning views. Because night will gradually fall, we will have dinner at the cross on Bartolo hill. There, at one of the highest points of this fabulous coastal range, we will meet an astronomer who, complete with a laser and telescope, will reveal the secrets of the cosmos to children and adults alike. We will descend by the light of the stars, helped by head and hand torches, taking in the best views of La Plana and bringing an unforgettable experience to a close.

# THE WILD PARTIES AT BENICASSIM'S VILLAS (REENACTMENT).

Description: The Villas district, particularly the area popularly known as "El Infierno" (or, Hell), was famous in the early 20th century for the lively (and looonnng) parties held by the wealthy property owners. We will see the preparations for one of these wild parties by a servant who, much to his dismay, will have to heed the countless whims of a maniacal and pretentious mistress.
