BENICÀSSIM'S EDIBLE FOREST

Sunday, 10th March (10 a.m.- 1 p.m.)

Place: Carmelite Monastery car park

Distance: 4 km. (easy - medium. Recommended for hiking families.)

Price: €3 (€1.5 reduced)

Description: The Mediterranean forest is a hot spot of biodiversity worldwide. This translates into a multitude of uses for plants: medicinal, construction, manufacturing, food... We are allowed to say that we have edible forests that offer us a multitude of services, some even unknown. Recover with us an almost forgotten ancestral wisdom!

Recommendations: sports shoes, hat, lunch and a drink. Animals are not allowed during the activity (except for guide and assistance dogs).

BENICÀSSIM: A CINEMA'S ROUTE

Saturday, 16th March (11 a.m. - 12.30 p.m.)

Place: Torre de Sant Vicent. (Ferrandis Salvador ave., 1)

Distance: 2.5 Km (easy, recommended for adults).

Price: €3 (€1.5 reduced)

Description: A walk at sunset where we will visit the scenes of Berlanga and other directors who brought to the big screen some of the most recognized landscapes in Benicàssim.

Recommendations: Animals are not allowed during the activity (except for guide and assistance dogs).

THE GHOST OF MÉCHAIN AND THE PARIS MERIDIAN (REENACTMENT)

Sunday, 24th March (10.30 a.m. - 12.30 p.m.)

Place: Desert de les Palmes Monastery carpark Cv-147 / Km. 8

Distance: 1 km (50m gradient) easy. Recommended for families.

Price: €5 (€2.5 reduced)

Description: It is a little-known fact that one of the minds behind the metric system conducted research in the hills of the Desert de les Palmes to determine the exact length of a meter. Pierre Méchain died from a disease transmitted by a mosquito in the area and was buried in Castellón. Yet his ghost, which can be seen on nights around All Saints' Eve, continues to wander the hills of Benicàssim in an attempt to cross them and return to his native France.

Recommendations: sports shoes, cap and a drink. Animals are not allowed during the activity (except for guide and assistance dogs).

Difficulty: easy. Recommended for families.

Description: Geocaching is one of the most fun ways for our little ones to really dive into their surroundings: using a GPS and coordinates gathered as a family, participants will arrive at a variety of places where, during this event, they will discover fun facts about the rich natural heritage surrounding the Desert de les Palmes Natural Park's Information Centre. Let's play!

Description: The peculiar sandstone geology of the territory of Benicàssim not only influences the water of our fountains or the vegetation that covers the mountains, but it also results in the most beautiful postcards in which the greens, reds and blues of the natural landscape combine in an unusual and surprising way.
