Family eco-route:

Eco-tourism at its best, this route allows you to get to know Benicàssim's privileged natural setting up close. An area of land bordered by both sea and mountains, it is home to a large variety of flora and fauna, and a landscape full of stunning contrasts.

Vía Verde del Mar "Greenway":

Formerly the site of the railroad linking Benicàssim and Oropesa del Mar, it is now an eco-friendly route that can be followed on foot or by bike. It runs along the coastline and it gives you views over two of the old look-out posts that protected Benicàssim's coast against pirate raids.

For the more adventurous, Benicàssim also has family-friendly hiking routes to choose from. For instance, the walk up to Montornés Castle or the Route of the Spires of St. Àgueda which, starting at the town hall, takes you on a circular route through some of Benicàssim's most beautiful landscapes.

Cultural tourism also has a place in Benicàssim's family tourism offer. The guided tour of the Torre de Sant Vicent Interpretation Centre and visits to La Bartola Interpretation Centre are just two of the many activities on offer in Benicàssim so that you can enjoy family tourism at any time of the year.

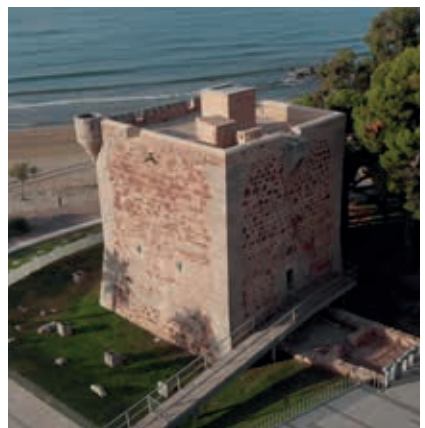
GET TO KNOW OUR HERITAGE



Benicàssim's unique history has left it with a wealth of artistic heritage that can be enjoyed all year round.

The Route of the Villas, running along the seafront promenade between Hotel Voramar and St. Vincent's Tower, will take you back in time to the Belle Époque and the height of high society's summer frolics at the turn of the twentieth century. If we head into the town itself, we will find St. Thomas of Villanueva church, and the Teatre Municipal Francesc Tàrraga, which offers up a varied programme of theatre, music, workshops, exhibitions and films all year round.

And if Benicàssim's tangible historical heritage isn't enough, consider also the sheer number of local festivals in honour of patron saints. St. Anthony and St. Àgueda are celebrated in January. In February there is the pilgrimage, also in honour of St. Àgueda. In September comes the turn of St. Thomas of Villanueva. Not forgetting the magical St. John's Night, on 23rd June.



BATHE ON OUR BEACHES



Benicàssim has more than six kilometres of beaches, Blue Flag beaches that have also been awarded the Spanish Tourism Quality Institute's "Q" certificate and ISO 14001. To talk of Voramar, Almadraba, Torre de San Vicente, Els Terrers and Heliópolis beaches is to talk of quality beaches, fully-adapted to the needs of not only families, but people with different levels of physical disability who want to bathe in the Mediterranean.

Not only can you sunbathe, take a dip and generally relax, but there are also lots of sports and other activities on offer. Volleyball, sports fishing, sailing, outdoor gym equipment, yoga, windsurf and children's play areas suitable for even the smallest of your group.

Benicàssim also has two beach libraries which, with a wide selection of children's books, allows you to lose yourself in a fictional world while sat in the shade of palm trees, listening to the sea's waves.



FAMILY ADVENTURE



Benicàssim has not forgotten the more active families, offering up a whole range of activities and entertainment to satisfy their taste for adventure.

You could start at the bowling alley, then up the stakes at the go-kart centre as you go careening around the circuit at full speed. Or why not head straight to the water slides and other family-friendly craziness at Aquarama theme park? Benicàssim's fully-equipped Skatepark is the ideal place for practicing tricks and turns on your skateboard, BMX or roller skates.

Benicàssim also offers routes through the Desert de les Palmes natural park for nature lovers. For future adventurers who still haven't taken their first steps, the municipal pool has a children's psychomotricity swimming programme to boost the development of even the littlest ones.



FOR CHILDREN



All year round, Benicàssim offers a wide-ranging programme of activities for all the family, such as its variety of guided tours, the "Imagina Benicàssim" festival of magic and the "Torre a la Vista" children's festival, amongst others. Fun is guaranteed for children with Benicàssim Kids, which includes "The Mystery of Parc del Trenet" and "Treasure of Sant Vicent Tower" obstacle courses, and the Heliópolis Beach puppet show. The Sant Vicent Tower Information Centre also offers a virtual reality guided tour experience.

Plus the Francesc Tàrraga Municipal Theatre boasts a programme adapted to all ages. Benicàssim's range of leisure activities is rounded off with arts and crafts workshops, traditional games and environmental education, the "Enjoy Saturdays" programme, and cultural activities in the town's libraries.
