## **BENICÀSSIM GUIDED TOURS OFFICIAL PROGRAMME**

### **From poor farmers to petty bourgeoisie (dramatised).**

**Sunday, 6th April 2025.**

**Schedule:** 10:30 am - 12:00 pm.

**Location:** Casa Abadia Tourist Office.

**Distance:** 1 km.

**Difficulty:** Low.

**Price:** €5 (€2.5, reduced).

**Recommended audience:** all audiences.

**Description:** The territory of Benicàssim was not good for agriculture. Or at least that agriculture that allowed local families to live off of it. Olive and carob trees were barely growing among the stony terraces. Not even the erudite Perez Bayer managed to reverse the situation despite his efforts. But, from 1850, everything will change with the arrival of the muscatel grape and the train. Several and different fun characters will make you relive some moments of historical changes, since the Muslim era, with the uncertainty that comes with starting or a new world or life without knowing what they will find, but with the conviction of leaving their descendants a better life.

**Recommendations:** During the provision of the service, access with animals is not permitted (except guide or assistance dogs).

### **Benicàssim with different eyes. Characters, curiosities and other stories.**

**Saturday, 12th April 2025.**

**Schedule:** 10:30 am – 12:30 pm.

**Place:** Tourist Info Casa Abadía. <https://maps.app.goo.gl/nzYLNf2TmrTjK3iU6>

**Distance:** 2.5 km.

**Difficulty:** Low.

**Recommended audience:** All audiences.

**Price:** €3 (€1.5, reduced).

**Description:** As often happens in cities that have experienced all kinds of social, historical and economic vicissitudes for centuries, Benicàssim is full of traces that are sometimes imperceptible even to the most attentive of visitors. Between works of urban art, sculptures, impossible architectures, renowned musicians and sculptors, illustrated characters or bohemian artists, and all kinds of stories and comics, heroes and villains, we will move to discover the most secret things of our town. In addition, we will be accompanied by a **sign language interpreter**, in order to promote communication between deaf, hard of hearing and deafblind people, and the other people. The need to have this service **must be confirmed 48 hours before the guided tour**.

**Recommendations:** During the provision of the service, access with animals is not permitted (except guide or assistance dogs).

### **Mindfulness in the Desert. Immerse yourself in the heart of nature.**

**Sunday, 17th April 2025.**

**Schedule:** 6:30-9:00 pm.

**Place:** La Bartola Interpretation Centre.

**Distance:** 1.5 km.

**Difficulty:** Low.

**Recommended audience:** Adult audience.

**Price:** €5 (€2.50, reduced).

**Description:** Mindfulness is a meditation technique that consists of observing reality in the present moment, without intentions to judge and with full openness and acceptance. An expert psychologist in mindfulness will accompany you to help you to live a transformative experience for many people, in an incomparable setting, which will consist of a route of the senses followed by a meditation workshop in the middle of nature.

**Recommendations:** athletic clothing and shoes, lunch, and plenty of water. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness, or are recovering from one.

### **Silent landscapes of saints and hermits.**

**Friday, 18th April 2025.**

**Schedule:** 9:30 am – 12:30 pm.

**Location:** Old Monastery viewpoint (car park). <https://goo.gl/maps/xEZLcGjbzyczXciSGA>

**Distance:** 5 km.

**Difficulty:** Moderate.

**Price:** €3 (€1.5, reduced).

**Recommended audience:** Previous hiking experience. Children from 7 years old.

**Description:** The brightly red and green landscapes in the mountains of Benicàssim create the most beautiful postcards that captivated, more than three centuries ago, the austere and eremite Carmelite

fathers. The sacred red rocks will be the focus of a route that will begin and end with the spirit Carmelite flying over our heads.

**Recommendations:** Warm clothing and hiking shoes, food and water. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness or if you are recovering from it.

### **Martha and Ernest, an idyll in wartime (dramatised).**

**Saturday 19th april 2025.**

**Schedule:** 10:30am to 12:30pm.

**Place:** Hotel Voramar and route of the villas.

**Distance:** 2 km.

**Difficulty:** Low.

**Recommended audience:** Adults.

**Price:** 5 € (2,5 € reduced).

**Description:** The Villas of Benicàssim were requisitioned by the Republican government during the last Spanish Civil War, serving as hospitals and logistic centres to care for the wounded of the International Brigades and the battles of Teruel and Madrid.

The Voramar Hotel also housed such renowned war journalists as Ernest Hemingway and one of his partners, Martha Gellhorn, considered by many to be the first female war journalist in history. It will be they and their convulsive relationship that will guide us along a rarely seen route of the Villas.

**Recommendations:** Animals are not allowed during the service (except assistance or guide dogs).

### **Balancing at Desert de les Palmes**

**Tuesday 22nd april 2025.**

**Schedule:** 8:00 am to 12:00pm.

**Place:** Desert de les Palmes Monastery carpark. <https://goo.gl/maps/pkyhn3xpnog61qwh6>

**Distance:** 7,5 km.

**Difficulty:** moderate / high.

**Recommended audience:** Hikers (from 8 years old).

**Price:** 3 € (1,5 € reduced).

**Description:** We will take a fascinating hiking route absolutely full of natural surprises and with the best views, not only of the coast of Benicàssim and a good part of the whole province, but also of the rugged and green interior of the province, as well as of the distant Peñagolosa, the Giant Stone that connects all the people of Castellón with our ancestors. We will walk along the Crests of the Desert and we will finish the route by climbing Mount Bartolo, the mythical peak of the natural park where a hero of French science, Pierre Méchain, developed his theories of the metric system.

**Recommendations:** Shoes and light sportswear, water and lunch.

### **B&B. Benicàssim and Biodiversity, inseparable!**

**Saturday, 26th April 2025.**

**Schedule:** 10 am – 1:00 pm.

**Location:** Desert de les Palmes, Mas de Salandó car park (after the bridge over the AP-7).

**Distance:** 4 km

**Difficulty:** Moderate (some steep inclines, stony ground)

**Recommended audience:** Previous hiking experience.

**Price:** €3 (€1.50, reduced).

**Description:** The territory of Benicàssim, so touristy and lively for urbanites, hides an unnoticed treasure by most visitors: an unleashed and surprising biodiversity. A landscape interpreter, on a simple hiking route, will reveal the natural secrets of the most emblematic protected area of Benicàssim. The local fauna and flora, their uses and their most amazing behaviors, will show you why it is one of the most biodiverse ecosystems in the world. In addition, we will be accompanied by a **sign language interpreter**, in order to promote communication between deaf, hard of hearing and deafblind people, and the other people. The need to have this service **must be confirmed 48 hours before the guided tour.**

**Recommendations:** mountain clothing and footwear, long sleeve, food and water. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness or if you are recovering from it.
