### **Día Mundial de los océanos (Oceans' World Day)**

Sunday, June 8, 2025

Approximate time: 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Location: Heliópolis Beach (quiet area – exact location will be provided after registration)

Recommended audience: Families

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced).

Description: In celebration of World Oceans Day, we invite you to a very special family day at Benicàssim beach. We'll begin with a participatory cleanup focused on the impact of plastics and microplastics in the sea, and end with an exciting moment: the release of a rescued sea turtle, which we'll get to meet up close before accompanying it back to the sea. An activity full of environmental awareness.

Recommendations: Comfortable clothing, a hat, water, sunscreen, and a strong desire to take care of the sea.

Difficulty: Low

Recommended audience: General public

Description: This guided tour is unique: rarely does a tourist tour begin by saying that no one wanted to live in the place they're visiting. How can that be, when today we're in one of the most coveted cities? Benicàssim hides a huge number of secrets. Starting with its original core at the Centinela Castle, we'll explore the streets and squares, discovering the historical figures and initiatives that, despite many challenges (which will be explained along the way), ultimately gave rise to a town that, against all odds, became a pioneer in the tourism sector throughout Spain and became known as the Biarritz of Valencia. This visit offers the service of a **sign language interpreter**, which must be requested at least **48 hours in advance**.

Recommendations: Animals are not permitted during service (except assistance or guide dogs).

### **Sol Invictus. Celebrating the Summer Solstice (with yoga initiation session)**

Sunday, June 22, 2025

Approximate time: 6:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m.

Location: Voramar Beach (in front of the Voramar Hotel)

Difficulty: Easy

Distance: 2 km (linear)

Recommended audience: adults

Price: €5 (€2.50 reduced).

Description: For millennia, the Sun has been the guide of the world's greatest civilizations: it governed the destinies of all, marking the beginning of harvests, sowing, and floods, instilling fear with its gradual disappearance in autumn or hope with its return in spring, and illuminating the entrances to the caves where the first human beings lived. In today's world, perhaps we would benefit from becoming more integrated into the cycles of Nature. To do so, we will explore the Sun's best-kept secrets on a simple beach hike at sunrise on the winter solstice. To fully transform ourselves into Sun worshippers, we will become fully aware of it and its presence with a fantastic yoga initiation session.

Recommendations: beach shoes and a change of shoes (barefoot walking is recommended), lunch, water, a yoga mat, or towel. Please do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness, or are recovering from one.
