Description: Genets, martens, weasels, and badgers are some of the beautiful local animals we have in our mountains that few people know about. Mediterranean fauna is both fascinating and elusive, as it is generally nocturnal. Therefore, we know of their presence by finding their traces: footprints, plumage, droppings, even sounds that will guide us on the path of true naturalists.

Recommendations: Water and dinner, several layers of clothing, athletic shoes, and mosquito repellent.

Mindfulness in the Desert. Immerse yourself in the heart of nature

Description: Mindfulness is a meditation technique that consists of observing reality in the present, without judging and with full openness and acceptance. An expert psychologist in mindfulness will accompany you to help you to live a transformative experience for many people, in an incomparable setting, which will consist of a route of the senses followed by a meditation workshop in the middle of nature.

Recommendations: sports clothing and shoes and water. Do not attend the activity if you have a serious injury or illness or if you are recovering from it.
