General conditions:

All visits in the Official Guided Visits Program have limited places. The purchase can only be made in advance, at the Benicàssim Tourist Offices or at turismo.benicassim.es

Payment will be made exclusively by bank card.

You must be at the departure point of the route at least 10 minutes before the start. We appreciate your punctuality.

In the event of cancellation of the visit for reasons beyond the control of the customer, the ticket will be exchanged for another ticket of the same amount with availability of places or its refund.

Visits with a sign language interpreter must be booked 48 hours in advance.

Benicàssim through different eyes. Characters, curiosities and other stories

(Wheelchair accessible and sign language available)

Thursday 2nd April from 10:30 a.m to 12.30 p.m.

Distance: 2.5 km

Difficulty: Low.

Recommended audience: All audiences.

Price: €3 (€1.5 reduced).

Description: As often happens in cities that have experienced all kinds of social, historical and economic transformations for centuries, Benicàssim is full of traces that are sometimes imperceptible even to the most attentive of visitors. From works of urban art, sculptures, impossible architectures, renowned musicians and sculptors, to illustrated characters or bohemian artists, and all kinds of stories and comics, heroes and villains, we will move to discover the most secret of our town. In addition, in this visit we will be accompanied by a sign language interpreter, in order to promote communication between deaf, hearing impaired and deafblind people and hearing people. The need to have this service must be confirmed 48 hours before the visit.

Recommendations: During the provision of the service, access with animals is not permitted (except guide or assistance dogs).

Martha and Ernest, an idyll in wartime (dramatised)

Saturday, 4th April from 10.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Place: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Low.

Recommended audience: Adults.

Price: 5 € (2,5 € reduced).

Description: The Villas of Benicàssim were controlled by the Republican government during the Spanish Civil War, serving as hospitals and logistic centres to care for the wounded of the International Brigades and the battles of Teruel and Madrid.

The Voramar Hotel also housed such renowned war journalists as Ernest Hemingway and one of his partners, Martha Gellhorn, considered by many to be the first female war journalist in history. It will be them and their convulsive relationship that will guide us along a rarely seen route of the Villas.

Recommendations: Animals are not allowed during the service (except assistance or guide dogs).

Silent landscapes of saints and hermits

Sunday, 5th April from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Location: Parking lot at the Old Monastery Viewpoint, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Distance: 5 km.

Difficulty: Moderate.

Price: €3 (€1.50 concession).

Recommended for: Experienced hikers. Ages 7 and up.

Description: The brilliant red and green landscapes of the Benicàssim mountains create the most beautiful scenes that captivated the austere and hermit Carmelite friars more than three centuries ago. The sacred red rocks will be the focus of a route that begins and ends with the Carmelite spirit hovering above us.

Recommendations: Warm clothing and hiking boots, lunch, water. Do not participate if you have a serious injury or illness, or if you are recovering from one.

B&B Benicàssim and biodiversity, inseparables * Includes sign language interpreter

Tuesday, April 7 (10 a.m -1 p.m.)

Location: Desert de les Palmes Natural Park, Mas de Saladó car park (after the bridge over the AP-7 motorway).

Distance: 4 km.

Difficulty: Moderate (some steep climbs, stony terrain).

Recommended for: Experienced hikers.

Price: €3 (€1.50)

Description: The Benicàssim area, so touristy and lively for city dwellers, hides a treasure that goes unnoticed by most visitors: a surprising and abundant biodiversity. Led by a landscape interpreter, on an easy hike, we will uncover the natural secrets of Benicàssim's most emblematic protected area. The local flora and fauna, their uses, and their most astonishing behaviors will clearly demonstrate why we are surrounded by one of the most biodiverse ecosystems in the world. In addition, a sign language interpreter will accompany us on this visit. The need for this service must be confirmed 48 hours prior to the visit.

Recommendations: wear hiking clothing and footwear, long sleeves, bring lunch, and plenty of water. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness, or if you are recovering from one.

Violant de Casalduch Urban escape room

Thursday, 9th April from 10.30 a.m to 12.00 p.m.

Location: Plaza de la Constitución (behind the Santo Tomás Church).

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended for: All ages.

Price: €3 (€1.50 concession).

Description: The streets of the town center will serve as our "room" where, through observation and ingenuity, participants will discover how to free this influential feudal lady who played a key role in the founding of Benicàssim. Violant became the Baroness of La Pobla Tornesa, the Sierra de En Garcerán, Borriol, Benicàssim, and the lands of Montornés Castle, but something caused her to become trapped in the town and unable to leave... What happened? What jeopardized the approval of the town charter that gave birth to our people? The clues won't be easy, and you'll need the keys to unlock the secrets that will be the thread to escape.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable shoes, light athletic clothing, and bring water.

Beautiful life at Villas of Benicàssim *Includes sign language interpreter and accesible for wheelchairs.

Saturday, 11th April from 11 a.m to 13 p.m

Place: Hotel Voramar. P. Pilar Coloma, 1.

Distance: 2 km (low difficulty).

Recommended audience: theme for adults. Children from 6 years old.

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced).

Description: From railway engineers, presidents of football clubs or bishops, to actors or opera singers, including famous writers or eccentric film directors. Such is the cast of historical inhabitants of the beaches of Torre de Sant Vicent, l'Almadrava and Voramar. And 150 years give rise to many stories around the villas of Benicàssim, perhaps the most eclectic and fascinating set of holiday villas on the Valencian coast, which we will discover with the help of a guide-interpreter. Accessible with a wheelchair.

Recommendations: During the provision of the service, access with animals is not allowed (except guide or assistance dogs).

Balancing at Desert de les Palmes

Sunday, 19th April from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Meeting point: Desert de les Palmes new Monastery car park.

Distance: 7,5 km.

Difficulty: Moderate / high.

Recommended audience: Hikers (from 8 years old).

Price: 3 € (1,5 € reduced).

Description: We will take a fascinating hiking route full of natural surprises and with the best views, not only of the coast of Benicàssim and a good part of the whole province, but also of the rugged and green interior of the province, as well as of the distant Peñagolosa, the Giant Stone that connects all the people of Castellón with our ancestors. We will walk along the Crests of the Desert and we will finish the route by climbing Mount Bartolo, the mythical peak of the natural park where a hero of French science, Pierre Méchain, developed his theories of the metric system.

Recommendations: Sneakers and sportswear, a bottle of water and lunch.

Mindfulness in the Desert. Immerse yourself in the heart of nature

Place: La Bartola Interpretation Centre. Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Description: Mindfulness is a meditation technique that consists of observing reality in the present, without judging and with full openness and acceptance. An expert psychologist in mindfulness will accompany you to help you to live a transformative experience for many people, in an incomparable setting, which will consist of a route of the senses followed by a meditation workshop in the middle of nature.

Recommendations: sports clothing, sneakers and a bottle of water. Do not attend the activity if you have a serious injury or illness or if you are recovering from it.
