# BEACHES

The coastal area of Benicàssim covers an area of **7 km** and is divided from north to south into five beaches: **Voramam, L'Almadrava, La Torre de Sant Vicent, Els Terrers, and Heliòpolis**. All these beaches have a Blue Flag and ISO-14001 Environmental Certification. Additionally, the first three are awarded with the "Q" for Tourist Quality distinction.

The beaches of Benicàssim are much more than just beaches; they are history when you get lost visiting the Villas of Benicàssim and travel back to the Belle Époque; or when resting in the shade of La Torre de Sant Vicent you travel to the Middle Ages and imagine the coasts besieged by corsairs; they are sport, as all of them have sports facilities, either for practising

on dry land or for venturing into the sea aboard one of the sailboats from l'Escola de la Mar or practising windsurfing.

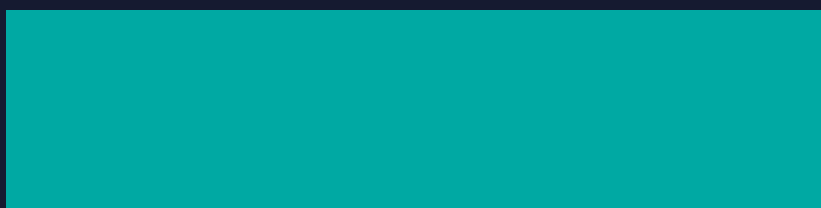
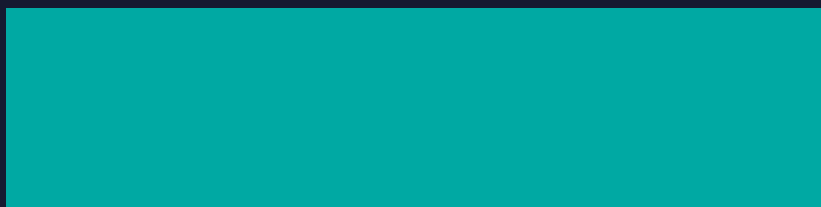
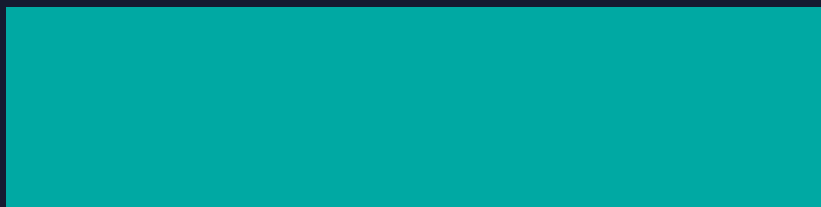
They are also leisure and relaxation if you enjoy a quiet walk along the promenade and stop at one of the terraces that dot the route here and there with a wide gastronomic offer.

# HELIÒPOLIS BEACH

Heliòpolis is the longest beach in Benicàssim. It is almost 3 km long and is the southernmost, connecting with the beaches of Castellón.

In summer, it has all the services to spend a good weekend for families with children, friends, or as a couple, as well as services by the sea such as the tourist office, water sports companies, a nautical station, and a sea library.

This beach is the starting point for the 16 km cycling and scenic route that connects with Castellón and la Vía Verde del Mar to Oropesa. During the summer, activities such

as beach gymnastics and tourist entertainment are carried out, as well as leisure activities such as beach cinema.

### Available services:

Showers and foot showers, accessible for people with reduced mobility, children's areas, umbrella, sunbed and pedal boat rental, boat area, public toilets, lifeguard service, sports areas and a sea library.

# ELS TERRERS BEACH

It has extensive services, such as the Generalitat Valenciana Sailing School, where courses are taught for all those who want to get started in the pleasure of sailing. A wide beach bordered by palm trees.

It offers two distinct areas: one of fine sand, where the Sailing School is located, and another of pebbles with a beautiful panoramic view from its viewpoint.

You can walk along its wooden walkways that allow for long walks by the sea. During the summer season, various activities are carried out, such as open-air cinema.

### Available services:

Showers and foot showers, lifeguard service, toilets, first aid, umbrella, sunbed and pedal boat rental, access for people with reduced mobility, sports area, boat signaling, sailing school.

# TORRE DE SANT VICENT BEACH

Named after the magnificent 16th-century watchtower that dominates this beach, it is one of the busiest throughout the year. It hosts a multitude of daytime and nighttime events throughout the summer, such as the Habaneras Festival, Nit de Sant Joan, and shows at the Pepe Falomir Amphitheatre. On its fine sand beaches, tourist entertainment, gymnastics, and numerous sports championships are also held.

### Available services:

Showers and foot showers, access available for people with reduced mobility, lifeguard, recreational games for children, umbrella, hammock and pedal boat rental stands, boat signaling, public toilets, sports area.

**Length: 650m**  
**Width: 85m**



# L'ALMADRAVA VORAMAR BEACH

This quiet beach, flanked by a pedestrian promenade, is located south of Voramar Beach and owes its name to an ancient fishing technique used by the people of Benicàssim. It's perfect for relaxing, and its warm waters and fine sand are separated from the surrounding beaches by breakwaters that protect it from the waves. It offers a wide range of services, including the Vil-la Ana Cultural Space. It is distinguished by its accessibility, with walkways that reach the seashore, changing rooms, and amphibious chairs with qualified staff for all bathers who require adapted bathing.

### Available services:

Showers and foot showers, access available for people with reduced mobility, lifeguard service, toilet signaling, sea library, changing rooms, toilets, umbrellas, hammock and pedal boat rental stands, boat signaling.

**Length: 600m**  
**Width: 60m**
