BENICÀSSIM GUIDED TOURS OFFICIAL PROGRAMME

General conditions:

All visits in the Benicàssim Guided Tours Official Programme have limited places. The purchase can only be made in advance, at the Benicàssim Tourist Offices or at turismo.benicassim.es

Payment will be made exclusively by bank card.

You must be at the departure point of the route at least 10 minutes before the start. We appreciate your punctuality.

In the event of cancellation of the visit for reasons beyond the control of the customer, the ticket will be exchanged for another ticket of the same amount with availability of places or its refund.

Visits with a sign language interpreter must be booked 48 hours in advance.

MARTHA AND ERNEST, A IDYLL IN TIMES OF WAR (DRAMATISED)

Sunday, 7th June (11 am – 1 pm).

Location: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended audience: Adults.

Price: €5 (€2.50 reduced).

Description: The villas of Benicàssim were requisitioned by the Republican government during the Spanish Civil War, serving as hospitals and logistics centres to care for the wounded from the International Brigades and the battles of Teruel and Madrid. In addition, the Voramar Hotel hosted renowned war correspondents such as Ernest Hemingway and one of his partners, Martha Gellhorn, considered by many to be the first female war correspondent in history.

Recommendations: Pets are not permitted during the tour (except for assistance or guide dogs).

B & B. BENICÀSSIM AND BIODIVERSITY, INSEPARABLE!

Saturday 13th June (8.30 am – 11.30 am).

Location: Desert de les Palmes Natural Park, Mas de Saladó car park (behind the bridge over the AP-7).

Distance: 4 km.

Difficulty: Moderate (some steep climbs, stony ground).

Recommended for: Experienced walkers.

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced).

Description: The area around Benicàssim, so popular with tourists and bustling with city dwellers, hides a treasure that goes unnoticed by most visitors: a wild and surprising biodiversity. Guided by a nature interpreter, on an easy walking route, we will uncover the natural secrets of Benicàssim's most iconic protected area. The local flora and fauna, their uses and their most astonishing behaviours, will make it abundantly clear why we are surrounded by one of the world's most biodiverse ecosystems.

Recommendations: hiking clothing and footwear, packed lunch, plenty of water. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness, or if you are recovering from one.

UNBEATEN SUN. CELEBRATING THE SUMMER SOLSTICE (WITH AN INTRODUCTORY YOGA SESSION) *Sign language interpreter provided.

Sunday, 21st June (6.00 am – 8.30 am).

Location: Voramar Beach (in front of the Voramar Hotel). 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Difficulty: Easy.

Distance: 2 km (linear).

Recommended for: Adults.

Price: €5 (€2.50 reduced).

Description: For millennia, the Sun has been the guide for the world's great civilisations: it ruled everyone's destiny, marking the start of harvests, sowing, and floods, instilling fear with its gradual disappearance in autumn or hope with its return in spring, illuminating the entrances to the caves where the first human beings lived. In today's world, perhaps we would do well to integrate ourselves more fully into the cycles of nature, and to that end, we will explore, on a simple walk along the beach at dawn on the summer solstice, the Sun's best-kept secrets. To complete our transformation into sun worshippers, we will become fully aware of the sun and its presence through a fantastic introductory yoga session.

Recommendations: beach shoes and a change of shoes (we suggest walking barefoot), breakfast, water, a yoga mat or towel. Do not attend if you have a serious injury or illness, or if you are recovering from one.

A NIGHT OF SELENOLOGY. THE SCIENCE AND MYTHOLOGY OF THE MOON.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended for: All ages.

Description: Selene, Diana, Artemis, Hecate, Shi, Khafira... The Moon has been – and remains – a central element in the religions and beliefs of civilisations across the globe. In the light of our sister satellite, it is regarded as a small planet around which the Earth revolves.

Biology, astronomy, mythology and poetry will come together to reconnect us with the lunar rhythms on a level no one could imagine.

Recommendations: Water, torch, comfortable footwear and clothing.

Join us on this journey to follow in the footsteps of screenwriters, directors and actors who have brought the landscapes of Benicàssim to the silver screen and starred in the most incredible stories, including the intrigues and gossip typical of the eclectic society of the last century. Berlanga, Bardem, Rafael Gil, Brigitte Bardot, Sara Montiel and Blasco Ibáñez are just some of those who will walk alongside us.
