Trackers that remain hidden

Saturday, August 1st (6.30 p.m. – 9.30 p.m.)

Location: Trails around the La Bartola Interpretation Centre, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Difficulty: Low.

Distance: 3 km.

Recommended for families.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: Genets, beech martens, weasels, and badgers are some of the beautiful local animals inhabiting our mountains—creatures few people know about. Mediterranean wildlife is fascinating yet elusive, as these animals are typically nocturnal. We discover their presence by finding signs they leave behind—tracks, feathers, droppings, and even sounds—that will guide us along the path of true naturalists.

Recommendations: A bottle of water, a snack, a hat, sunscreen, and sports clothing and footwear.

The Good Life at the Villas of Benicàssim

Tuesday, August 4th (6.30 p.m. – 8.30 p.m.)

Location: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 2km (very easy).

Recommended for adults. Children aged 6 and over.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: From railway engineers, football club presidents, and bishops to actors, opera singers, celebrated writers, and eccentric film directors, the beaches of Torre de Sant Vicent, l'Almadrava, and Voramar have been home to an extraordinary cast of historical figures. Over the past 150 years, the villas of Benicàssim have witnessed countless fascinating stories, making them perhaps the most eclectic and captivating collection of holiday villas on the Valencian coast.

This tour is wheelchair accessible.

Recommendation: Pets are not allowed during the activity, with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs.

Benicàssim Through New Eyes: People, Curiosities, and Other Stories

Saturday, August 8th (6.30 p.m. – 8.30 p.m.)

Location: Tourist Info Casa Abadía, 74–76 Santo Tomás Street.

Distance: 2.5 km (easy).

Recommended for all ages.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: As is often the case in towns that have experienced centuries of social, historical, and economic change, Benicàssim is full of traces that can go unnoticed even by the most observant visitor. From urban art, sculptures, and striking architecture to renowned musicians and sculptors, distinguished historical figures, bohemian artists, and all kinds of stories, legends, heroes, and villains, this tour will take you on a journey to uncover the town's best-kept secrets.

Recommendations: Pets are not allowed during the activity, with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs.

Martha and Ernest: A love story in times of war (Dramatised)

Tuesday, August 11th (6.30 p.m. – 8.30 p.m.)

Location: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended for adults.

Price: €5 (€2.50).

Description: During the Spanish Civil War, the Villas of Benicàssim were requisitioned by the Republican government and used as hospitals and logistical centres to care for wounded soldiers from the International Brigades and the battles of Teruel and Madrid. Voramar Hotel also accommodated renowned war correspondents such as Ernest Hemingway and Martha Gellhorn, one of his partners and widely regarded as one of the world's first female war correspondents. Their turbulent relationship will guide us through a unique tour of the Villas, revealing a fascinating chapter of Benicàssim's history.

Recommendations: Pets are not allowed during the activity, with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs.

Scape Room at the Desert de les Palmes Interpretation Centre

Saturday, August 15th (6.30 p.m. – 8.30 p.m.)

Location: La Bartola Interpretation Centre, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park

Distance: Around the Interpretation Centre.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended for all ages (6 years and over).

Price: 3€ (€1.50).

Description: Although this escape room takes place outdoors, participants of all ages will find themselves more trapped than they might expect. By carefully observing the natural surroundings, they must help a lost family of foxes solve the mystery that is preventing them from roaming freely through the mountains of Benicàssim. Ready to play?

Recommendations: Please bring water and wear comfortable clothing and suitable footwear.
