When some sleep, others wake up

Thursday, July 16th (7 p.m. – 10.30 p.m.)

Location: Parking of the ancient Monastery viewpoint at the Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Distance: 5 km (moderate difficulty).

Recommended for ages 8 and up.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: We will explore the Desert de les Palmes from a new perspective: that of its nocturnal inhabitants. At each stop along the route, we will encounter a different habitat inhabited by numerous animals that, due to their nocturnal nature and despite their beauty, go completely unnoticed by most of us. But don't forget: even if you don't see them, they are there.

Recommendations: Comfortable shoes, light athletic clothing, long sleeves, a bottle of water, dinner, and a flash-light.

A Love Story Between the Sea and the Train

Saturday, July 18th (6.30 p.m. – 9.00 p.m.)

Location: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 4 km.

Difficulty: Low.

Recommended for adults.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: The renowned Joaquín Coloma—a pioneer of Valencian bourgeois tourism—and his wife, Pilar Fortis, settled in Benicàssim not only to oversee the railway lines he was designing but also because they were captivated by the natural paradise they discovered in our bay. Sea and mountains, intrepid stonemasons, and watchtowers merge with the ghostly echo of the roaring trains along one of the last stretches of wild coastline in the Castellón region. Join us to rediscover the stories behind the hidden, wild side of the "Valencian Biarritz."

Recommendations: Suitable footwear, sportswear, and water.

A crazy party at the Benicàssim Villas (dramatised)

Tuesday, July 21st (6.30 p.m. – 8.00 p.m.)

Location: Voramar Hotel. 1, Pilar Coloma Promenade.

Distance: 1 km.

Difficulty: Low.

Recommended for all ages.

Price: €5 (€2.50).

Description: The "Villas" area—specifically the section popularly known as *El Infierno* (Hell)—was famous in the early 20th century for the lively parties hosted by its wealthy owners. We will witness the preparations for one of these wild gatherings through the eyes of a servant who, much to his dismay, must cater to the endless whims of a demanding, pretentious mistress—the owner of Villa Elisa, where several scenes will take place.

Recommendations: Pets are not permitted during the tour (with the exception of guide dogs or assistance dogs).

Trackers that remain hidden

Thursday, July 23rd (6.30 p.m. – 9.30 p.m.)

Location: Trails around the La Bartola Interpretation Centre, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Difficulty: Low.

Distance: 3 km.

Recommended for families.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: Genets, beech martens, weasels, and badgers are some of the beautiful local animals inhabiting our mountains—creatures few people know about. Mediterranean wildlife is fascinating yet elusive, as these animals are typically nocturnal. We discover their presence by finding signs they leave behind—tracks, feathers, droppings, and even sounds—that will guide us along the path of true naturalists.
Recommendations: A bottle of water, a snack, a hat, sunscreen, and sports clothing and footwear.

Family Fest: musical geocaching in the streets of the town

Saturday, July 25th (6.30 p.m. – 8.00 p.m.)

Location: Constitución Square (behind the Santo Tomás de Villanueva church).

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Easy.

Recommended for families.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: Benicàssim is synonymous with music; genres such as flamenco, jazz, blues, classical guitar, rock and roll, indie pop, reggae, and many others come together throughout the year in its streets and at the festival grounds of this world-famous musical destination. Through an exciting, sound-filled activity, we will introduce both adults and children to one of the healthiest cultures there is: the culture of unconditional love for music.

Recommendations: Sports clothing and footwear, and a bottle of water.

A Night of Selenology: Science and Mythology of the Moon

Tuesday, July 28th (9.30 p.m. – 12.30 a.m.)

Location: Voramari Hotel (The Green-way- *Vía Verde del Mar*).

Distance: 4 km.

Difficulty: easy.

Recommended audience: All ages.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: Selene, Diana, Artemis, Hecate, Shi, Khafira... The Moon has been—and remains—a central element in the religions and beliefs of civilizations across the globe. Our sister satellite is viewed as a small planet around which the Earth orbits. Biology, astronomy, mythology, and poetry will blend to reconnect us with lunar rhythms in ways one could hardly imagine.

Recommendations: Water, a flash light, and comfortable footwear and clothing.

Silence! Shooting in progress

Friday, July 31st (6.30 p.m. – 8.30 p.m.)

Location: Torre de Sant Vicent – along the Route of the Villas.

Distance: 2 km.

Difficulty: Low.

Recommended for adults.

Price: €3 (€1.50).

Description: Since the early 20th century, the Valencian region has been fertile ground for producers and directors from around the world to establish not only their film sets but even their homes. Join us on a journey to follow in the footsteps of the screenwriters, directors, and actors who brought Benicàssim's landscapes to the silver screen—and who starred in extraordinary tales, as well as the intrigues and gossip typical of the eclectic society of the last century. Berlanga, Bardem, Rafael Gil, Brigitte Bardot, Sara Montiel, and Blasco Ibáñez are just a few of the figures who will walk alongside us.

Recommendations: Comfortable footwear and clothing, water.
