B&B: BENICÀSSIM & BIODIVERSITY – INSEPARABLE!

Tuesday, 18 August (8:00 am – 11:00 am)

Meeting point: Desert de les Palmes Natural Park, Mas de Salandó car park (after the bridge over the AP-7 motorway).

Distance: 4 km (moderate difficulty, with some steep uphill sections and rocky terrain).

Recommended for: Participants with hiking experience.

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced rate).

Description: Benicàssim is well known for its vibrant atmosphere and tourism, but beyond the town lies a hidden treasure that many visitors never discover: its extraordinary biodiversity. Accompanied by a landscape interpreter, you will enjoy an easy hiking route through the area's most iconic protected natural space, uncovering the secrets of its remarkable natural heritage. Discover the local flora and fauna, learn about their traditional uses and fascinating behaviours, and find out why this region is part of one of the world's richest biodiversity hotspots.

Recommendations: Wear suitable hiking clothing and footwear, including a long-sleeved top. Bring a packed breakfast or snack and plenty of water. Do not participate if you have a serious injury or medical condition, or if you are recovering from one.

SILENT LANDSCAPES OF SAINTS AND HERMITS

Saturday, 22 August (6:30 pm – 9:30 pm)

Meeting point: Old Monastery Viewpoint car park, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Distance: 5 km (moderate difficulty).

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced rate).

Recommended for: Participants with hiking experience. Suitable for ages 7 and over.

Description: The striking red and green landscapes of Benicàssim's mountains create breathtaking scenery that captivated the austere Carmelite hermits more than three centuries ago. The sacred red sandstone formations will be the highlight of this hiking route, which begins and ends beneath the enduring spirit of the Carmelite order, still present throughout these historic mountains.

Recommendations: Wear warm clothing and suitable hiking footwear. Bring a packed breakfast or snack and plenty of water. Do not participate if you have a serious injury or medical condition, or if you are recovering from one.

MINDFULNESS IN THE DESERT. CONNECT WITH YOUR INNER SELF IN THE HEART OF NATURE

Tuesday, 25 August (6:30 pm – 9:30 pm)

Meeting point: La Bartola Interpretation Centre, Desert de les Palmes Natural Park.

Distance: 1.5 km (easy).

Recommended for: Adults.

Price: €5 (€2.50 reduced rate).

Description: Mindfulness is a meditation practice that involves observing the present moment with openness, acceptance and without judgement. Guided by a psychologist specialising in mindfulness, you will enjoy a deeply enriching experience in an exceptional natural setting. The activity includes a sensory walk followed by a sunset meditation workshop, offering a unique opportunity to reconnect with yourself while immersed in nature.

Recommendations: Bring water and wear comfortable clothing, a long-sleeved top, and suitable walking footwear.

A LOVE STORY BETWEEN THE SEA AND THE RAILWAY

Saturday, 29 August (6:30 pm – 9:00 pm)

Meeting point: Hotel Voramar.

Distance: 4 km (easy).

Recommended for: Adults.

Price: €3 (€1.50 reduced rate).

Description: The renowned Joaquín Coloma, a pioneer of bourgeois tourism in the Valencian Community, and his wife, Pilar Fortis, fell in love with Benicàssim not only because of the railway line he helped design, but also because they discovered a natural paradise in its beautiful bay. Along this route, sea and mountains, the legacy of the stonemasons, historic watchtowers and the echoes of the railway come together in one of the last remaining stretches of unspoilt coastline in the province of Castellón. Join us as we uncover the stories behind the hidden and untamed side of what was once known as the Valencian Biarritz.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable walking shoes, suitable outdoor clothing and bring plenty of water.
